‘Ohana Miguel shares their experience of how HCA made their homeownership dreams a reality.

“Starting in transitional housing, HCA became our lifeline – fixing credit, building savings, and facilitating our move to a long-term rental. Clinton’s employment at Goodfellows transformed our fortunes, leading us to Maui. With newfound stability, homeownership became a dream. HCA’s referral assisted our rental transition, while the acceptance of our children into a Hawaiian Immersion school pushed us towards our Big Island home purchase. Despite challenges, HCA’s unwavering support and encouragement kept us on track, maintaining a monthly budget. Through perseverance, prayers, and HCA’s guidance, we conquered the financial hardships that marked the start of our journey.”



Learn how Tricia took accountability and action of her finances.

Initially residing in low-income housing, HCA helped Tricia set up three goals: increase credit score, increase income, and increase savings. Knowing HCA counselors were keeping Tricia accountable to her financial goals was transformative and crucial to her progress. She embraced budgeting, and with HCA’s support, Tricia stuck to a budget and significantly boosted her savings. Since her first counseling in 2021, she surpassed her top goals by raising her credit scores by 127 points, increasing income by \$6885.24 annually, and elevating savings by \$8564.73.

MAUI RESPONSE

The August 2023 wildfires devastated our Maui community and State. Since then, we have activated our team at the CHNA resource center, walked door to door to offer support, and continue to look for opportunities to be in service to those who lost their homes, jobs, and more.

In two short months following the fires, HCA served 188 clients with the creation of 6-month sustainability plans and extended our counseling services to those who were interested. We stand ready to rebuild in the years ahead.
